Takeoff & Check-In Times:

- 6:30 am takeoff and 10:30 am check-in

Takeoff & Postgame Show Procedures:

Takeoff will be by boat number starting at 6:30 a.m. All boats must check-in at Big Toho Marina at 10:30 am.

There will be a pretournament meeting to discuss takeoff and postgame show procedures at 6 am in front of the MLF stage trailer.

All boats must go through a boat check as they exit the marina. Please have your personal flotation devices on and fastened, open your live-wells as you idle out of the marina. We will toss you your boat number and once clear pull your shut-off device to show us it is in working condition.

You must check-in if you have fish or not. The check-in person will be located in front of the marina just inside the no-wake buoys. At that time, please toss your boat number to the check-in staff. If you are at the no-wake markers at the designated check-in time, you will not be counted as late.

This is a ScoreTracker Live, catch, weigh and immediate release tournament. Each team will be provided with a BUBBA Smart Fish Scale and connected device. The scale and connected device must be turned in at the stage trailer following check-in.

Do not take your boat out of the water until after turning in your equipment and crossing the stage at our postgame show.

We recommend both guests and pro partners go to the stage for the postgame show to talk about your day on the water and to promote your brands.

We must have a liability release signed before you can go fishing.

Rules:

1. Contestants must have a valid Florida fishing license.
2. Tournament officials reserve the right to refuse any entry.
3. Participants under 18 years of age must be accompanied by a parent or adult with written parental permission.
4. No entry will be accepted on the day of the event.
5. During tournament hours no alcoholic beverages are to be consumed by tournament contestants or allowed in tournament boats.

6. All boats must be equipped with some type of emergency ignition cut-off device when the engine is in use.
7. U.S. Coast Guard approved personal floatation devices are required for each person on board. PFDs must be worn and fastened when outboard engine is in use.
8. No boat shall have a motor of higher horsepower than the approved Coast Guard maximum.
9. Boat numbers will be determined by your registration time and dates.
10. No fishing inside the break wall at Big Toho Marina.
11. All bass must be caught on artificial bait.
12. All boats are required to turn in numbers at the designated check-in location. Failure to turn in boat numbers at the official checkpoint will result in late penalties being imposed.
13. Contestants who are not in the official check-in area at the appointed time shall be penalized 1 pound per minute.
14. Any contestant who is more than 15 minutes late for check-in will be disqualified from the tournament.
15. After contestants have been recognized and have turned in their boat number to the designated check-in boat, they will be allowed ample time to proceed to the stage trailer; however, all fishing must cease upon check-in.
16. Only largemouth bass weighing 2 or more pounds will be scored.
17. A photo of each scoreable bass must be submitted in the ScoreTracker Live app.
18. Each bass may only be scored one time.
19. Ties will be broken first by total number of bass, then by biggest bass, then by second biggest bass. If a tie remains, it will be broken by earliest entry (lowest boat number).
20. All decisions of the tournament directors and staff are final.
